- Call 999 and alert manager and team members of the fire.
- Attempt to move any animals that may be effected by the fire and exit the area as quickly as possible. If it takes too long to locate or secure them you must leave the animal. You should never delay escape or endanger yourself.
- Report to the manager and go straight to the meeting point, leaving all belongings.
- Once responders get there, immediately inform them of any animals that are in need of rescue. The responders will then put in their efforts to rescue any animals.
- Take leads and carriers on your way out of the effected area. The safe area may not be known to the animal, it may be chaotic and that could cause the animal to try to escape to a calmer, safe area.
- Never go back inside a burning building. If you can't find an animal, leave, open any cages, and call to them repeatedly from a safe distance away. Let firefighters take over the task of locating any animals.
